viewCoursesStudentList.do	The removed list has an "enrol" link but only against the first student name. It should be against all names, and against the names on the rejected list as well (you can change your mind!). There seems to be a general oddity here, as on the "all" list I have an "enrol" link against the top "removed" person under one course (first on list, and first category), but against none of them on another course lower in the list.	<b>Yes</b>
enrollStudent.do	<b>Just a text change :</b> On re-enrolling a student who was removed, the text at the top of the form refers to "pending" status, which was slightly confusing to a tutor who reported it. Can we change This student is pending enrolment on "Maths for Engineering", to This student will be enrolled on "Maths for Engineering"
